



### Language Requirements

Catalan is the language of the Institut del Teatre. However classes can be given in Catalan or Spanish, at the discretion of the professor. To be admitted as an ERASMUS student it is necessary to prove a B1 level of Spanish, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Students must submit a certificate stating the level of language together with the application or they may send it later, before the start of classes. The institution is not responsible that students can register for the required credits if they don't have a language level equivalent to B1.

If at the time of joining the courses students cannot prove a B1 of Spanish, they will be able to take the corresponding courses but, in order to get the credits they will have to submit a document certifying that they have done a language course equivalent to B1, by the end of the mobility period. We accept certificates issued by the OLS platform.

### Insurance

To be able to enroll ERASMUS students must have the European Health Insurance Card and a private insurance that covers them in case of accident during mobility. Should the students have no insurance information will be provided so that they can buy an insurance policy.



## NIE and visas

### 1. Students of the European Union

According to the Spanish law students of the European Union (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden and the United Kingdom) or Liechtenstein, Iceland, Norway and Switzerland residing in Spain for a period exceeding three months must apply for a residence permit (NIE) in the *Central Registry of Foreigners*. ### 1. Students from outside the European Union

Before entering Spain students must obtain a "visa for studies" at the consulates of Spain in their country of origin or legal residence. To do this they will need a document that certifies that they have been accepted as an ERASMUS student. In order to stay legally in Spain students will have to apply for a residence permit (NIE) in the *Central Register of Foreigners*. This document will enable them to travel within the European Union as well as to those countries that signed agreements of free movement with them. - Deadline for submission of applications for the first semester: **May 15**
- Deadline for submission of applications for the second semester: **October 15**

Initially we only accept application for one semester, with the possibility of extending the mobility period throughout the year. This will depend on the integration of the student during the first months of the mobility.
