Acceptance	Students will receive a response within a month from the deadline

Insurance	Incoming students must have sufficient insurance covering all risks (health, accident and liability) during their entire stay in Spain. Students from an EU/EEA country have to obtain the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).
Accommodation	No on-campus housing, but Institut del Teatre has an agreement with Barcelona Centre Universitari (BCU), the official accommodation service for the universities and research centres in Barcelona. BCU can guide incoming students in finding accommodation: https://bcu.cat/en/
Language courses	Catalan is the language of the Institut del Teatre, however classes can be given in Catalan or Spanish, at the discretion of the professor. Attending a Catalan language course is recommended, for Autumn Term students we can offer a free Catalan course, and there is also the possibility of taking free courses throughout the year with other institution called <i>Consorci per a la normalització lingüística</i> : https://www.cpnl.cat/en/inscripciones/ Catalan can also be studied online through the free platform Parla.cat: https://parla.cat/login/index.php?lang=en
